

Further Description of Important Features <u>HOUSE IS CONSTRUCTED OF BRICK WITH STONE LINTELS & STILLS. A WOODEN PORCH WRAPS AROUND THE S.E. CORNER OF THE HOUSE. THERE ARE SEVERAL LARGE ARCHED WINDOW INFILLED WITH EITHER STAINED OR CUT GLASS. ALSO SOME SMALLER ARCHED WINDOWS WHICH ARE ARRANGED IN PAIRS. THERE IS A TOWER ON THE S.W. CORNER OF THE HOUSE WHICH IS OCTAGONAL IN PLAN. OAK IS USED ON THE INTERIOR WOODWORK & FIRE PLACE MANTELS.</u> 43. History and Significance <u>HOUSE IS LOCATED NEAR THE ORIGINAL WEISHEIMER MILL WHICH STARTED ABOUT 1865. BY 1897 JACOB HAD PROSPERED SO, THAT HE BUILT A NEW HOME. WHICH WAS BUILT FOR \$5400. TEATERS HAVE OWNED THE HOUSE FOR ABOUT 10 YEARS THE BARN AT THE REAR OF THE HOUSE WAS PROBABLY BUILT ABOUT THE SAME TIME AS THE HOUSE.</u> 44. Description of Environment and Outbuildings <u>LOCATED NEAR THE OLENTANGY RIVER NEAR THE ORIGINAL WEISHEIMER MILL. THERE IS A BARN TO THE REAR WHICH IS USED AS A GARAGE.</u>
