

42. Further Description of Important Features (Continue on reverse if necessary) Low ranch-style house is of concrete block construction with rock-faced ashlar stone trim on lower half of front wall. Windows are multi-paneled, steel casement, brick veneer sills. From front view, house appears to be L-shaped. Extended wing has gable roof and outside wall having 3 different materials: stone on lower portion, then corrugated transite sheeting, then wood siding at top. Front door is recessed & wood paneled. Inside, fireplace has black marble facing; window sills are marble.				41. Distance from and = 27', Frontage on Road = 120'
43. History and Significance House was built for Fordyce & Dikka Ely. Dr. Ely was professor of Dairy Science at OSU. Next owner was Walter & Irma Wills and present owner is their daughter. This lot was once part of the adjoining property of Florence & George H. Bulford, 4765 N. High. Mr. Bulford was a prominent architect.				5. Other Name(s) ELY
