

Prowler Is Fired Upon After Smashing Window

A porter at the Beechwold Barbecue, 4784 North High street, fired upon a man early Monday who attempted to enter the place by smashing a rear window after he had been refused admittance.

Patsy Ciprianno, the porter, told police he was scrubbing the floors when a man knocked on the front door and asked to use the telephone. He refused. Shortly afterwards, Ciprianno stated, the man broke the glass in the rear window. The porter said he grabbed his gun and fired at the man, who fled.
