The cold snap gave firemen their busiest workout in recent weeks. 18 runs being made between 4:58 a. m., Sunday, and 3:37 a. m. Monday.

Eleven of the trips were made to residences where someone had become frightened as sparks emerged from chimneys.

Most serious damage resulted at the Beechwold barbecue, 4848 North High street, where fire caused by an overheated furnace system resulted in \$1200 damage, at 3:37 a. m., Monday.
