Funeral Set Tuesday For P. J. Freemans

Service for Peter J. Freemans, 4922 Olentangy Blvd, Columbus veterans leader, will be at 2 p. m. Tuesday in the Greek Orthodox Church, where he was a member and past president of the board of trustees. Mr. Freemans died of a heart attack Saturday at his home.

Owner of Pete's Drive-In, 4850 N. High St, he formerly owned the New-Rex Billiard Parlor at High and Chestnut Sts, for 40 years.

Mr. Freemans was a charter member and past commander of Columbus Post No. 82, American Legion. He was a past commander of the Franklin County Council, American Legion, and has been a delegate to the council from Post 82 for 25 years.

He was treasurer of the War Veterans Republican Club of Ohio and Franklin County and a past chairman of the Franklin County Memorial Committee.

He was past Chef de Gare, Voiture No. 15, 40 et 8, and was chairman of the building committee for the new home of Post 82.

He was treasurer of the Last Man's Club and a member of the Northern Kiwanis Club.

Mr. Freemans was president of the Pan-Adrearian Federation of American Lodge and past president of the AHEPA.

He is survived by his wife, Betty, and two sisters, Mrs. Sophia Kussurelis, and Mrs. Christina Roumeliote, both of Columbus.
