## Five Persons Named In Suit for Damages

Five persons were sued for a total of \$5110 in common pleas court Monday by Theresa Moody, 2696 Olentangy River road, who charged she was injured May 30, 1939, when struck by a beer bottle in the Moose Head tavern, Olentangy river road and Dodridge street.

The defendants were Flora Debus, 1085 Rex street; John Betts, 1009 McKinley avenue; Harry Snyder and Mrs. Harry Snyder, 530 Seibert street, and Charles Cook, 1013 McKinley avenue.

Miss Moody charged that each of the defendants was "actively engaged in a general fight" and that during the melee she, a "helpless bystander," was struck by a beer bottle. She said she suffered extreme humiliation because she was compelled to wear a bandage on her head to her commencement exercises.
