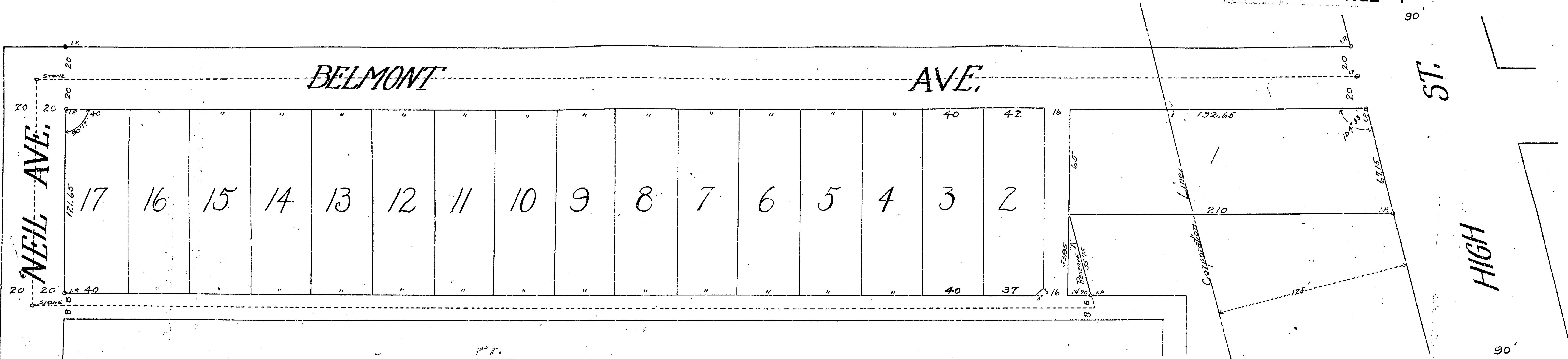


OJEDA

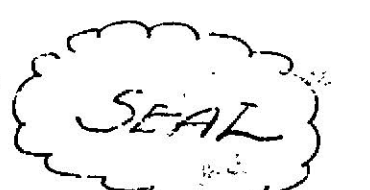
