

# CHESNUT ADDITION.

TO THE CITY OF COLUMBUS OHIO.

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Description-Beginning at the South West corner of East Bank of Olentangy River at a lime stone, thence S. 86° 05' E 2328.5 to a post in West line of High St, thence N. 10° 45' W. 387.30 ft with said High St. line to a chiseled cross on a culvert coping, thence N. 87° 05' W. 2313.45 ft, to a stake on River Bank, thence S. 9° 56' 16" E. 345.35 ft. to Stake at point of beginning.

Survey - Monuments set as shown on plat. All lot corners are staked. Bearings Magnetic, Distances given in feet. Scale of Plat 1/4" = 100 ft. Date Oct. 14" 1894. Surveyed by H. R. Postle
