Still has original driveway of 2 strips of concrete.</u> <u>One story "family" room, with sun deck, joining house to garage.</u></p> <p>43. History and Significance <u>The original owners were William (an asst. prof. at OSU) and Mary Graham. Present owner is an OSU physics professor.</u></p> <p>44. Description of Environment and Outbuildings <u>Additional 1/2 lot heavily wooded, many varieties recently planted trees. House angled to have view of both river and ravine/park. Incredibly large clump (3) of sycamore in front of living room window. Very possibly one of those mentioned in abstract land markers for Beechwold Plat.</u></p> <p>45.
