Handsome modern "Scandinavian" style house; architect designed and supposedly inspired by Frank Lloyd Wright. 6"-wide dado is around house just above 1st floor windows -- appears to be "impressed" design in concrete; casement windows; porch on rear facing Olentangy River. Bas relief centered between two front windows (bas relief of a sower) and a statue by Prof. Frey occupies an opening (arched) in the house wall.



43. History and Significance Prof. Irwin Frey was the sculptor at The Ohio State University for many years. His works are found in the Columbus Museum of Art, at the Courthouse complex, on the Oval at OSU (the statue of President Thompson), and elsewhere. The Freys built this home and Mrs. Frey currently lives here (although in ill health) after 59 years.

44. Description of Environment and Outbuildings

The Olentangy River is just to the west, altho there is little evidence of direct use of the river site. Immediately to the south of the house is a sharp hillside dropping down into a ravine that transects Old Beechwold from about High St. west to the river. This provides a dramatic setting for the house.
